Dementia:

Course Description

The prevalence of dementia worldwide is expected to nearly triple from estimates of 57 million in 2019 to over 150 million by 2050 (Nichols et al., 2022). Timely and accurate detection of dementia is crucial for improving dementia care and patients' quality of life, reducing caregiver burden, and decreasing care costs (Rasmussen & Langerman, 2019). Mental health providers play an important role in the dementia detection and treatment process in older adults. This course will provide an overview of current practices in dementia care, including assessment of cognitive functioning in older adults, treatment practices, and emerging research on lifestyle interventions for dementia prevention.



Emily W. Paolillo, PhD is a neuropsychology fellow at the UCSF Memory and Aging Center. She obtained her PhD degree in Clinical Psychology (emphasis in Neuropsychology) from the San Diego State University/UC San Diego Joint Doctoral Program in 2021, which included a predoctoral clinical internship at VA Palo Alto Health Care System. Her research interests include evaluating digital health tools for early detection and monitoring of Alzheimer's disease and related dementias, as well as understanding lifestyle behaviors that confer risk and resilience to dementia.
